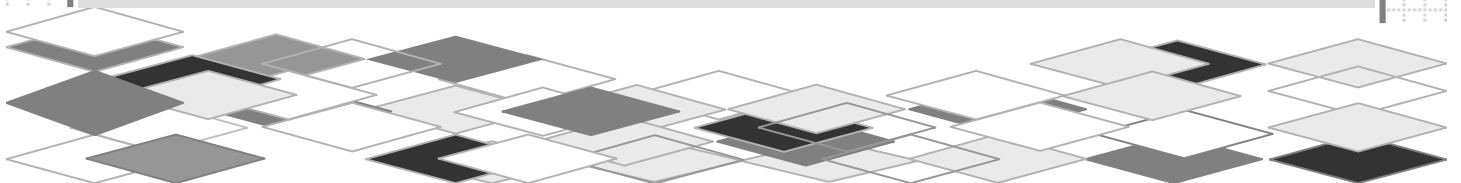

FACTORY HANDLING

The range of factory handling equipment for glass companies includes equipment for supporting the processing equipment within the factory. This includes general purpose factory carts, special purpose factory carts, safety fencing, and lifting equipment.

General purpose factory A-frame Cart

These allow single glaze lites and IGUs to be easily and safely moved or stored. We supply three standard models of factory A-frames and also manufacture to suit. The Glass Racking Company carts are made using hot dipped galvanized steel with our own non-marking polymer inserts for bearing surfaces, and safety arms for secure support and protection of the glass.

Special purpose factory carts

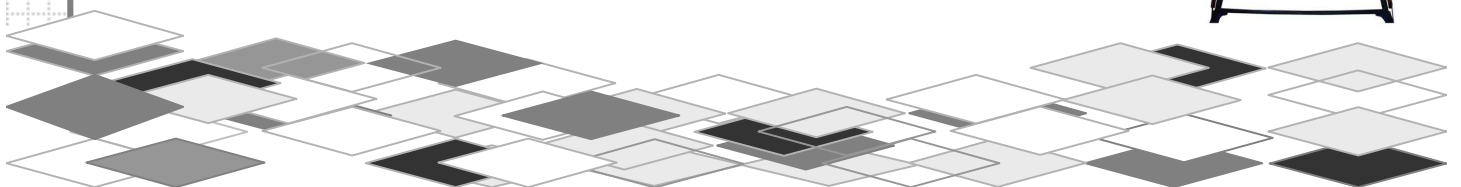
Our range of special purpose carts includes horizontal finger racks, harp carts for single glaze, harp carts for IGUs, tooth carts for storage and movement of IGUs, spacer bar carts, and more.

Safety fencing

A range of solutions is available for safety fencing and these are custom built for each factory.

Factory Lifting

The Glass Racking Company range of factory lifting equipment includes overhead cranes and packlifters. The packlifters allow for the quick and safe loading, lifting and unloading of pack glass from containers and also between storage systems within a factory.

CUTTING AND PROCESSING

The Glass Racking Company supplies a range of cutting and transfer tables. All the tables have a high density felt cutting surface, hardwood edging, and are engineered to withstand the weights of freefalling sheets of glass.

The cutting tables have options for manual tilt, electric tilt, air, and breaking bars. The manual tilt tables are balanced to allow the operator to tilt the table from horizontal to near vertical to allow the loading and unloading of glass.

The electric tilt tables are controlled from the side of the table or using a remote.

The air tables use our own unique blower system. The power of the blower is designed to suit the sheet sizes, thicknesses and weights to be cut.

The breaker bars are used to automatically break the cuts made to the glass.



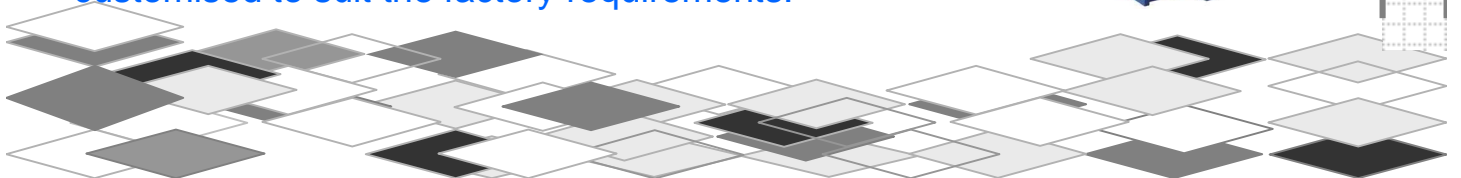
STORAGE

The Glass Racking Company storage systems include swing racks and concertina racks. Both types of storage are extremely space efficient, and allow access to the glass load from the front (and rear for Concertina) as well as from above.

Swing racks allow ease of storage and access to job lots of glass.

Concertina racks are typically used for bulk storage of stock glass.

The sizing of Swing and Concertina racks is customised to suit the factory requirements.

GLASS CARRIERS

The Glass Racking Company range of glass carriers includes vans, pickup's, open site trucks, covered trucks, and transportation A-Rack trucks.

The Glass Racking Company vans racks include both internal leaners and racks, and also externally mounted racks. The pole and polymer block securing system make this and our other transportation systems very quick and easy to load and unload while protecting the glass.

Pickup racks either utilize the existing structure of the pickup (OEM pickup box and third party bed) or can be built up from a bare cab chassis.

Open site trucks typically carry greater weight than vans and pickups, and are becoming more attractive.

Covered trucks for glass transportation are typically tarp sided with container style doors for rear access to internal racks. The glide-top roof system allows overhead access to the internal storage for loading packs and larger items.

Transport A-Rack trucks are dedicated to transporting loaded A-Racks to customer sites, and can include a rear mounted Moffett forklift.
