VAN GLASS FRAIL UPGRADES

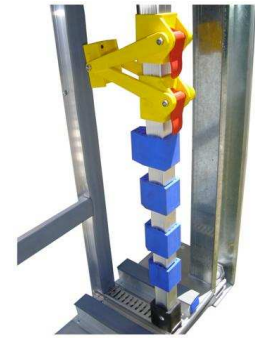


This brochure highlights the upgrade options available for older Metalcraft van frails to utilise the features of the new frail technology without requiring a complete replacement.

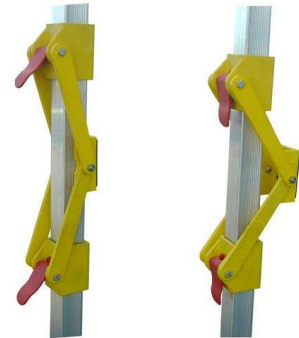

UPGRADE OPTIONS

The new blue non-marking polymer blocks replace the traditional black rubber blocks. They slide smoothly up and down the sprung poles in any weather, and leave the glass unmarked.



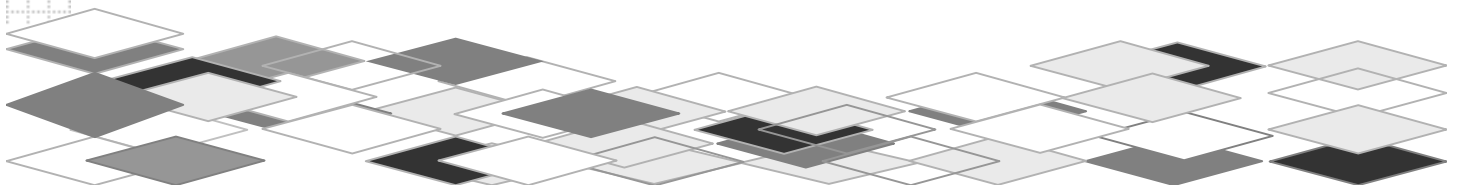
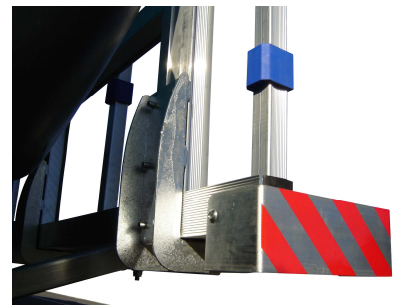
The new yellow scissor clamps provide extended reach from the sprung pole to the load, and are an ideal addition to the top of existing poles for loads of a few tall sheets and bulk shorter sheets. New plungers are available for older model clamps to reduce slippage.



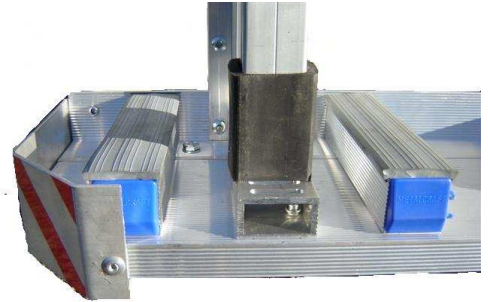
The new galvanised mild steel top pole locator bracket and ledge support bracket are strongly constructed to reduce the effect of an impact or collision. These components are high tensile mono-bolted into position for ease of replacement and upgrade.



The new underbody mount bracket is a swivelling support which reduces the effects of an impact or collision, reducing damage to the rack and vehicle.



The new grey non-marking polymer on the raised base blocks supports and carries the glass load, protects the load from the frail structure and road debris, and reduces load movement



Height extensions for the rack and poles is available allowing raised or lowered positioning. The height adjustment is normally an additional 500mm of height, adjustable in five increments. This allows for a lower rack for most applications with a simple extension when required. This is a very popular and simple upgrade with significant benefit.



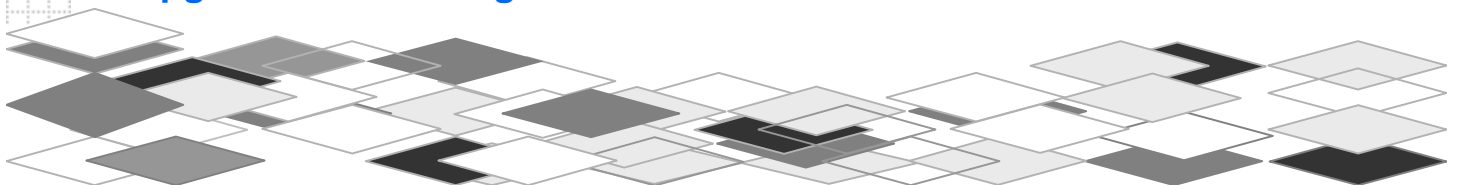
The new stainless window stop cleat connects to the end verticals of the frail and allows webbing straps to be used to secure window frames onto the frail, making the frail multi-purpose for transportation of glass, window frames, and other fragile large or awkward flat product.



Internal frails can be either a simple leaner frame or a frail with poles and ledge with base blocks. Design can be either L-frame or A-frame, with options for fixed or sliding out the rear of the van even when fully loaded. Internal frails increase capacity and loading options.



The Glass Racking Company also provide new van frails and the 3.5M Glazier and 4.5M Contractor site vehicles which are very attractive upgrades for existing van users.



BENEFITS

The Glass Racking Company van frails have been designed and manufactured using high tensile mono-bolts at the connection points rather than welds. This means that components can be easily and cost effectively upgraded

The Glass Racking Company has service companies which can assist with upgrades

Some upgrades are user installable, depending upon skill set and equipment available. Installation guides can be provided with upgrade kits

Metalcraft components are not available for sale. The items described in this brochure are upgrade kits for existing van frails
